### 9. Constitution/Bylaw Updates - will vote on updates in two meetings

- a. Non-voting membership changed to honorary membership wording change
- b. Clarification in wording for officer selection
- c. College replaced with collegiate
- d. Changing officer meetings from at least once to at least 3 times /semester
- e. Giving president permission to change meeting with 72 hr advance notice
- f. Bylaws:
- g. Grammatical changes
- h. Chief of staff- responsibility of writing yearly report with the president (previously Communications)
- i. Treasurer default presidential appointee
- j. Presidential elections: absolute majority rather than simple majority
- k. College Affairs: if no one is nominated for position, elections will again occur after next semester
- I. Invalid elections: final authority for determining invalid election given to Student Court
- m. All execs: responsibility to attend both general/executive meetings
- n. Combining Mentorship and FELD Committees
- o. Adding a chair for Equity and Inclusion
